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Summer Greetings to all PS 58 Families!

We are pleased to share Fall classes for 2025. You will see old favorites along with some exciting new additions. Enrichment registration opens on Monday, August 4 at 10:00am; aftercare registration opens on Monday, August 11. The registration site is http://www.ps58brooklyn.org/afterschool/registration/. Classes begin on Monday, September 8 and end on Friday, December 19, a period of 12 to 13 classes, depending on the day of the week.

Carroll Kids is YOUR afterschool program. We are part of the PS 58 PTA, and try to serve the needs of our families by providing high-quality enrichment classes and aftercare programming. As many as three-quarters of the school population use our services! Our program also provides recess counselors and supplies to help facilitate games and fun for all grades during the school day.

Students enrolled in enrichment classes are dismissed directly from their classrooms to Carroll Kids (which is why it is critical that you update your students' classroom information in Sawyer as soon as it's available). Enrichment students are escorted to the Auditorium to meet up with their instructors. All enrichment classes begin with a healthy snack. Most classes run for 90 minutes ending at 4pm. A few classes have multiple sessions like Guitar, Piano, Kung Fu and Tennis. More detail can be found in the class description. Enrichment class students may also enroll in Carroll Kids "late partial" aftercare if families need coverage until last pick-up at 6:30pm. Details on this concurrent program are available on https://www.ps58brooklyn.org/afterschool/carroll-kids/. Registration for aftercare opens on Monday, August 11 at 10:00am.

Be advised that some of our most popular classes fill up in the first minute after registration opens. Still, we are offering more than 90 classes this Fall so everyone can find a class that fits his/her interests and schedules. Class pricing is based on instructor fees, costs of administration and affording a small grant to the PTA. Many of our classes are taught by PS58 staff, and these classes are among our most popular as well as affordable. Other classes are taught by outside vendors and can be more expensive but allow us to offer a wider variety of classes. Financial aid is available to eligible families. Registration Tips

Afterschool Registration Website: http://www.ps58brooklyn.org/afterschool/registration/

- 1. Please only have one person from your family register. Some families are using multiple devices and people to access the registration site. We need to slow the traffic to ensure a better experience for everyone. Please be patient and don't refresh constantly. Add your child to waiting lists if you don't get a spot right away. There is usually movement from the waitlist on the very first day!
- 2. We use Sawyer for our online registration software. Please go online in advance of enrichment class registration to create an account for your family. There is an annual per family fee of \$25 which must be paid prior to registrations. <u>Click here</u> to purchase a membership for the 2025 2026 school year.
- 3. Check your login email and password in advance of registration. Take the time to reset your password if necessary.
- 4. Please only use one Sawyer account to register your family. It creates ongoing problems for us if students have more than one account. We will delete redundant accounts.
- 5. Sawyer uses a queue system much like Ticketmaster. This keeps the system from crashing. Please be patient.
- 6. Once registration opens, if you are interested in a class that you think might fill up quickly, put that class in your cart right away! When you add a class to your cart, your spot is held for up to 10 minutes. During that time, no one else can take that spot. But if you remove it from your cart or if you take more than 10 minutes to check out, the spot will re-open to anyone who adds it to their cart. **Please be sure to purchase before your 10-minute window closes.** The clock starts from the minute you add the first class to the cart.
- 7. If a class is full, join the waitlist. Spots often open up. When that happens you will automatically be entered from the waiting list, but you're not obliged to take it. If you don't want the spot, just let us know, and you will be fully refunded. If you don't get admitted to a class, you will get priority to register for the next session, provided the class is offered again.
- 8. DO NOT sign up for multiple classes on one day with the intention of dropping them after you make up your mind. Let's be kind and make sure everyone has fair access.
- 9. Please check to ensure that your child(ren)'s grade, classroom, medical info and pick up info are correct in your Sawyer account.
- 10. Please check your schedule using the Sawyer calendar when you are done with registration. It's the best way to confirm your class and aftercare registrations. You can find it by <u>clicking here</u>.

Drop & Refund Policy

We understand that plans can change, but please read our refund policy carefully before registering. Our policies are designed to keep things fair for all families and to ensure classes are filled efficiently.

August 4 - 11:

Families may drop a class for a refund, minus a \$25 administrative fee. To request a drop, please email carrollkids@ps58pta.org.

August 12 - September 7:

Families may drop a class for a refund, minus a \$150 fee. As classes become harder to fill, this higher fee helps to offset the cost of an empty seat. Please consider your schedule carefully during registration.

September 8 - 14:

Families may drop a class for a 50% refund of the class fee. Requests must be sent to carrollkids@ps58pta.org.

September 15 and beyond:

No refunds or credits will be issued for dropped classes.

We are firm on our refund deadlines to keep the process fair and sustainable. Dropping a class later in the registration period can prevent another child from participating. Please be considerate when selecting your classes—thank you!

Extended Enrichment Program

(2:25pm to 5:30pm includes ENRICHMENT CLASS + Aftercare)

We're excited to introduce a new hybrid offering within our afterschool program that combines enrichment classes with aftercare. This new "Extended Enrichment" model helps us make better use of our limited classroom space—particularly for in-demand sports and movement classes—and provides students with both creative engagement and supervised playtime in one seamless experience. Extended Enrichment will cover 3 hours of supervision per day, from the end of the school day until 5:30pm with no added costs. The cost will vary depending upon the class.

Each day will feature an enrichment class, and students will also participate in aftercare either before or after their class, depending on the day's schedule. This format allows us to offer some of our most popular classes—which typically have waitlists—to more students.

The price for the **Extended Enrichment** option will fall between the cost of a single enrichment class and full aftercare, making it a good value for families looking for a longer day that includes both structured learning and time to unwind. We're committed to keeping costs reasonable while covering the quality instruction and extended care your children receive.

Please note: These classes will only be available as part of the **Extended Enrichment** program and will not be offered separately this season.

We hope this new option meets the needs of families looking for more flexibility and depth in their child's afterschool experience. As always, we welcome your feedback and are happy to answer any questions.

Mondays (13 Sessions):

Gymnastics

Grades K - 3

Gymnastics is a sport of movement & skill. It builds strength, improves agility & develops overall balance and control. Action-packed with exciting skills to learn and movement routines that motivate and challenge! The coaches will assign students to groups according to age and ability. Class warms up with lively music, next we condition with cross mat tumbling (no waiting in lines!) Then our gymnasts are led through an obstacle course of Gymnastic & Circus skills as they master the challenges in their paths; all while having TREMENDOUS AMOUNTS OF FUN! Teachers: Gymstars Class fee: \$860

Ninja Parkour

Grades K - 3

Kids learn the basics of parkour, including rolling, jumping & vaulting. The class program is focused on developing strength, agility, balance, conditioning and confidence in children of all levels. The coaches assign students to groups according to age and ability. Weekly classes led by our professional coaches and training on level appropriate obstacles gives every child a chance to learn, grow and succeed.

Tuesdays (12 Sessions):

Basketball for Grades 2 - 5

Students will receive instructional basketball lessons covering dribbling, passing, shooting, and defense. This structured program is designed to develop fundamental basketball skills in an engaging and supportive environment. The first half of each class will focus on skill development and technique, while the second half will provide an opportunity to apply those skills through fun, game-based play. The class will be split into two levels so that beginners can build confidence while more experienced players are challenged appropriately.

Wednesdays (13 Sessions):

Flag Football for Grades 3 - 5

Students will practice the fundamentals of Flag Football: passing, catching, running, including strategies such as designing plays and running routes. Classes will include fun and safe games of Flag Football while building the important skills of sportsmanship and respect. The class will be split into two levels so that beginners can build confidence while more experienced players are challenged appropriately. Players will also learn how to communicate effectively with teammates and make quick decisions on the field. No prior experience is necessary—just a willingness to try, play hard, and have fun!

Thursdays (12 Sessions):

Basketball for Grades K & 1

In this fun and active class, students will build coordination and confidence through beginner basketball skills like bouncing, catching, passing, and aiming for the basket. We'll play movement games and simple team activities that help kids learn how to follow directions, take turns, and work together. Each session ends with a short game and a chance to celebrate what we've learned together. This class is all about movement, teamwork, and having fun!

Fridays (12 Sessions):

New Kids Tennis for Grades K - 5

New Kids Tennis is a relatively new USTA-sanctioned format that helps children learn and play the game of tennis. To make it easier for them a few things have changed -- the court size, the racquet sizes, the tennis balls, the scoring system and the height of the net. This means that more children will have the opportunity to experience the game, have fun playing with their friends and develop the skills that will become the foundation of their game. COACH Quennie will assign students to groups according to age and ability.

Full School Year Music Programs

PS58 is pleased to offer two comprehensive after school music programs: Anselmo Academy and Ezra Guitar. Both programs are long standing partners at our school, and current and former families are happy to share the wonderful experiences their children have had with both programs. Many students go on to play in prestigious programs in both middle and high school. Please be aware these programs are a full-year commitment. Payment plan options are available upon registration. Carroll Kids will provide "Bridge the Gap" coverage before lessons.

Anselmo Academy Group Piano Lessons

PS58 is very fortunate to host the Anselmo Academy for an 18th year of afterschool programming!

Group Lessons: Piano is taught once a week in small groups of 4 students based on grade and experience levels. Group classes run Monday through Friday in 40-minute time slots. In these group classes children learn Music and Piano skills, note reading and writing, rhythm and ear training, keyboard skills and Music Theory and History in a friendly, motivational environment.

At the time of registration you may indicate via email to carrollkids@ps58pta.org your preferences for the time slot, and we will do our best to accommodate, but we cannot guarantee specific days or time slots until all students are placed. The schedule may not be finalized until a week before classes begin. Obviously, if your student cannot attend the time slot assigned, you will be given a full refund.

Piano Lessons run through the end of the school year Monday through Friday on days we have enrichment classes (See <u>our calendar</u> for days with no class). Lessons begin Mon, Sept 8. Anselmo Academy hosts a formal recital for all students in the spring. 1st Session: 2:45pm to 3:25pm; 2nd Session: 3:30pm to 4:10pm; 3rd Session: 4:15pm to 4:55pm.

Students will need to purchase the necessary piano books after being assigned to an instructor.

EzraGuitar Group Guitar Lessons

Established in 2008, EzraGuitar is a guitar program designed to give kids the opportunity to study with some of the greatest classical guitarists of this generation, while using a method of learning designed especially for them. Our group classes are the core of the EzraGuitar method. These classes are built on the philosophy of Maoz Ezra, that music should be taught in the "language of children" and tailored to their natural abilities. By studying with this method and philosophy, it is our goal that children will connect to music making in a natural and organic way. Through creative games and ensemble work, children will leave each lesson with a sense of accomplishment and musical knowledge that will remain with them as a foundation for any future musical endeavors. EzraGuitar Kids Group Guitar Lessons (Grades K-5)

- We teach small group lessons for children in grades K- 5 (kids are grouped according to age & level, the course is cumulative.)
- Melody & Rhythm: through a mix of repertoire including, classical, folk, children's songs, rock, jazz, contemporary and original compositions, students will learn to play music, not only exercises.
- Reading music: Through our unique method children will learn to recognize, know and master the notes in a range of four octaves.
- Ensemble work: From the beginning children will be learning to play in an ensemble. This group work puts emphasis on listening with sensitivity and working together.
- Performance: At the end of each session, students will perform in a concert. Performance is a
 major part of studying music, it teaches the student about building self confidence and the joy of

Bridge the Gap Care

For classes with delayed start times – including Kung Fu, Capoeira, Piano, The Great Kids' Bakeoff and Guitar – we offer "Bridge the Gap" care. Students placed in classes that have a delayed start time (i.e. don't begin right at dismissal) will be automatically accepted in our Carroll Kids "Bridge the Gap" program for no additional cost. "Bridge the Gap" includes arts, crafts & games in the cafeteria. This care is ONLY for the time before a lesson or class. If you need coverage AFTER the class, we offer the option of "LATE" Carroll Kids care for an additional fee.

Enrichment Class Policies

Registration Fee

There is an annual non-refundable registration fee of \$25 per family, which covers your child for the entire school year (including camps) or any portion thereof. This is an administrative fee for the Carroll Kids Enrichment and Aftercare Classes to cover the cost of our software program. It does not cover, nor can it be applied to, the program fee. This is a one-time yearly fee per family and covers all enrollments including enrichment classes, music program and aftercare.

Behavior Issues

We reserve the right to expel any student who continually disrupts a class. In this event, we will refund any missed classes in full.

Payment Plans

We offer payment plans through Sawyer for classes over \$400. These do have a surcharge of 2%. Full year music programs will have payments on 9/15, 10/15, 11/15 and 12/15. Full year academic programs (chess & French will have three payments on 9/15, 12/15 & 3/15). Enrichment classes will have 2 payments with half due at enrollment and half due on 9/15.

Class Minimum & Wait Lists

Classes must reach a minimum of six students to run. The determination about whether the class will run will be made the first week of the session. In the event that a class is canceled due to low enrollment, students may receive a credit toward a spot in a class with space or receive a full refund. If a class fills and goes to a waitlist, students on the waitlist will be registered automatically should a spot become available. You are not obligated to take the spot and a refund will be given if you don't accept the spot. The software system maintains a list of students in the order in which the registration was received. If you don't receive a spot, you will be given priority to register during the next session if the class is offered.

Acting & Scene Writing

With guidance from an experienced chess coach, students will engage in competitive games, analyze matches, and participate in challenging chess puzzles, empowering them to become formidable players and strategic thinkers in the fascinating world of chess. Join us for a journey of chess mastery and intellectual growth! The class is divided into a short lesson, free play, and a tournament.

Led by *Ready, Set, Chess*, our PS58 chess-in-the-classroom program creates a warm, welcoming space where beginners can discover the joy of the game. Each session includes a quick lesson, time to play with friends, and even a mini tournament to test out new moves. It's the perfect mix of learning, playing, and a little friendly competition—all year long!

Filmmaking & Screenwriting

Young screenwriters work under the guidance of a professional screenwriter in the style of Writopia's creative writing workshops. Writers will also delve into film and TV show analysis with screenplay excerpts and explore the ways in which acting, production, and directing all influence the choices one makes when crafting a script. All finished screenplays result in a table read. Teacher: Writopia. Grades 3/4/5. Class Fee: \$705

French Foundations

The primary objective for this program is to increase students' vocabulary in French. The secondary objective aims at building upon a student's overall language structure and enhancing their receptive/expressive language skills in French. Each class will be built around a thematic unit belonging to a developmentally appropriate curriculum. Thematic units/topics include but are not limited to the following: a) animals, b) transportation, and c) body parts. (Mondays - 13 Sessions)

Kung Fu

Are you looking for a martial art that emphasizes discipline, self-improvement, and has a rich cultural history? Look no further than Wu GungTao Kung Fu—a traditional Chinese martial art practiced for centuries to develop both physical and mental strength. In this class, students will learn foundational techniques such as kicks, punches, and blocks, all in a respectful and supportive environment led by an experienced instructor. Through the practice of *forms* (sequences of movements), students will also build focus, discipline, and self-awareness, while exploring the philosophy and history behind this ancient practice.

Grades K-1 and Grades 1-2:

These sessions follow a standard, once-per-week format ideal for beginners. Students will be introduced to basic techniques and foundational principles at a steady and engaging pace. *Grades 3–5:*

This level introduces more advanced techniques and requires greater focus and physical coordination. To support real progress and skill advancement, the instructor strongly recommends enrolling in both the Monday and Tuesday sessions. Attending both days ensures consistent training, deeper understanding, and the opportunity to develop more challenging skills. Throughout the course, students will set personal goals and work closely with the instructor to meet them—building confidence, resilience, and a lifelong appreciation for martial arts.

Aftercare Policies and Procedures

Aftercare will begin on Monday, September 4 for Kindergarten through Fifth Grade. PreK aftercare will begin on Monday, September 11. Please be aware we will not be able to accept drop-in care for students in enrichment classes on September 4 and 5.

Coverage Options

We offer onsite aftercare from the end of school (2:25pm for most students) until 6:30pm. Students must enroll for a trimester at a time.

Full: End of school until 6:30pm Early: End of school until 4:15pm

Late: 4:15pm until 6:30pm (aftercare after an enrichment class)

Pick-up procedures

Aftercare students can be picked up at the Carroll Kids desk in the school lobby at any time from 2:50pm to 6:30pm. If you find it difficult to pick up by 6:30pm, feel free to make a private arrangement with one of our counselors. Otherwise, you will be charged a late fee.

To pick-up your child you must check-in at the lobby desk. Counselors will request ID until they recognize you, your neighbors, your sitters, and all others authorized to pick up your child.

Pick-up name changes

We will not release your child to anyone who is not on your Sawyer pick-up list unless we can confirm with you that s/he is an authorized pick-up person. If it's a one-time occurrence you can email us (carolynr@p58pta.org) in advance. Thank you in advance for keeping us posted!

Private counselor care arrangements

If you plan to have a counselor on your child's dismissal list, you will be asked to sign a waiver. Carroll Kids accepts no responsibility for counselor care arrangements after our program has ended. Please email carrollkids@ps58pta.org to request a waiver form. Please note it is our policy that Carroll Kids Counselors are not allowed to work with PS 58 families during our Aftercare program hours.

Please be prompt

We understand that people occasionally run late, but we ask you to keep in mind that our staff has commitments of its own beyond Carroll Kids. Should you run later than 6:30pm, a late fee of \$10 will be charged until 6:40pm and an additional \$15 until 6:55pm will be billed to your account. This is not an additional service, and unfortunately once the school building is closed your child and our counselor will not be permitted to wait inside the building. We reserve the right to drop students from the program when families exceed 5 latenesses. Late fees must be paid by the end of month.

Absences

Please notify us via email at carolynr@ps58pta.org if your child is going to be absent from our enrichment / afterschool program. When you notify us via email of your child's absence ahead of time (no later than 11am the day of) you allow us a larger window of time to call parents whose children ARE supposed to be with us, but are NOT. Thankfully, most of the time, we find that an absent child is exactly where he or she is supposed to be, but for safety's sake, we will never assume it is so. Hopefully, if you think of it this way, you will always remember to notify Carroll Kids when your child is going to be absent.

Schedule changes

For aftercare, we request that you honor your enrollment registration for the session (Fall/Winter/Spring). Every student must register again for aftercare each session even if their schedule remains the same. Please register during the registration period before a session begins so we can have our rosters ready for the first day of each session. Registration requests after each session begins will be considered on a space available basis. Days and grades do fill up.

Health and Medical

Allergies and other medical conditions

There is a section in the online registration form that asks about allergies and other medical conditions. Please provide as much information as we need to care for your child. Most often, families of children with SEVERE allergies or special dietary needs provide an alternate snack from home. We encourage parents of children whose needs require special attention or understanding to speak with us directly about his/her needs. We cannot stress enough how important it is that this information is shared with staff.

Minor injuries and illness

Our counselors provide routine treatment (cleaning, bandaging, and ice-packs) when necessary. We are also very fortunate to have our staff nurse on site until 5:30pm most days. Injuries other than minor scrapes and bruises get reported to our office staff, who will let you know by phone during the afternoon. If the office is unable to reach a parent, we will let you know in person at dismissal time. We will call right away if your child has a fever or informs a counselor that they are not feeling well.

Lost & found

Please label ALL of your child's belongings; there are no cubbies in aftercare. Check the lost and found for any missing belongings.

The PTA Carroll Kids Afterschool Program is not responsible for the loss, breakage, damage, or theft of personal property, including, but not limited to, electronics and musical instruments.

Behavior policy

Please take the time to remind your child that Carroll Kids is a place for all to have fun and that those children who treat others, whether staff or another child, in a way that the senior staff deems disrespectful or otherwise inappropriate, will be suspended or even withdrawn from the program if the problems persist. Carroll Kids will not be responsible for loss of/damage to personal property brought to Afterschool.

Inclement weather (unplanned closings)

Carroll Kids will always be closed when the public schools are closed for inclement weather. There are also days when the schools are open but the Department of Education closes all buildings at 3pm. On those days, we have no choice but to close Carroll Kids.

In the event we are forced to close, we will post an announcement on ps58brooklyn.org and send an email to parents and guardians.

Drop-in aftercare

Families who are registered with Carroll Kids, may enroll on a drop-in basis. You MUST pre-register to take advantage of Drop-Ins. Your account must be created at least 7 days in advance of your first Drop-In. We highly recommend setting this up at the beginning of the school year.

Drop-ins are available to families if there is space in our Aftercare program. Requests need to be made by email to carolynR@ps58pta.org at least 24 hours in advance. Please include your child's full name, classroom and the date you need childcare. For Mondays, please notify us by Friday. Once a Drop-in reservation is confirmed, it may not be cancelled. Drop-ins are \$69 per day per child for grades K – 5 and \$75 per day for PreK. Drop-ins are a full-day option only (school dismissal until LAST PICK-UP @ 6:30pm).
